

THOUGHT TO THOUGHT?
SCRIPTURE REFERENCES COMPARED KJV/NIV

The following is a very small sample of the reasons to use an Authorized King James Version (KJV) of the Bible. The “New” versions including the NIV, NASB, Living, etc. etc. are based upon an Eclectic (pick and choose) Greek manuscript that Wescott and Hort, of Cambridge, assembled in the late 1800’s from up to four manuscripts originating in Alexandria Egypt. The New Testament church had never received this new text until the very late 1800’s. The NIV is an accurate version intent of this new manuscript, however there are more than 84,000 words missing and over 5,000 doctrines in contradiction, changed or deleted because of the new manuscript. The Greek manuscripts the church had been receiving up to this time was the Majority Text or the Byzantine Family text that the KJV is translated from. Of the over 87,000 fragments (quotations, phrases, writings, lessons etc.) of texts found in the early churches, 100% has been of the Byzantine Family text. The Authorized King James Version is based upon a Formal Equivalency method of translation, meaning that a Greek word has been given an equal English word. The “New” translations are based upon a Dynamic Equivalency method of translation, meaning that since we do not know exactly what the original word of God is, the meaning (or interpretation) of the Greek words are expressed by the translator(s) in English. The New King James Version NT is translated from the Byzantine Family, but is not using the personal pronouns and other reading helps found only in the Victorian type English. The New King James Version also uses the ben Asher Family OT manuscripts originating from Spain which has been rejected by Israel because of its inaccuracies. The KJV is translated from the ben Chayyim Family manuscripts that Israel still uses and universally accepts as the Words of God. It seems that the stumbling block in this issue is the “King James Only” argument, that is only one of the Devil’s cunningly devised fables (2 Peter 1:16) of which there are several. The real issues are the source of the manuscripts being translated and the method of translation. How can you know what the word of God means if you don’t know what it says? Compare the following verses using the KJV and the NIV. The same can be used with virtually any of the “New” translations, obviously with variations, since they are translated from an eclectic manuscript with thousands of words missing, the variations between translations even amongst themselves is quite vast. The NASB has placed brackets around the verses they claim should not be included, and italicize words only for emphasis of the Dynamic Equivalence (see Jn 5:29). There are 84,098 words missing from the NIV New Testament alone, and approximately 5,000 doctrines changed.

Mat 19:9 Last 10 words about adultery are out. If you want to change society, you need to change societies standard.

Mat 20:16 Called/chosen (Vocation – general/effectual are reversed).

Mat 20:22 “and be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with” is out.

Mat 25:13 Wherein the Son of Man cometh” is out.

Mk 1:14 “Kingdom” is out.

Mk 2:17 “Repentance” is out.

Mk. 6:11 All of reference to Sodom and Gomorrah is out (23 words).

Mk 9:24 “Lord” is out.

Lk 2:33 “Joseph” is changed to “father” doctrine of the virgin birth is negated throughout. Luke was a physician and knew the doctrine of the virgin birth (Lk 1:1-3).

Lk 2:43 “Joseph and His mother” are changed to “his parents”.

Lk 4:4 “but by every word of God” is out.

Jn 3:13 “which is in heaven” is out.

Jn. 3:15 “should not perish” is out.

Jn. 3: 16 “begotten” is out. Satan must remove the deity of Jesus Christ to accomplish his agenda.

Jn 3:18 “begotten” is out.

Jn 6:47 “on me” is out.

Rom 1:16 “of Christ” is out.

Rom 15: 29 "of the gospel" is out.
 1 Cor 11:24 "take eat" is out.
 1 Cor 16: 22 "Jesus Christ" is out.
 1 Cor 16:23 "Christ" is out.
 Gal 4:7 "through Christ" is out.
 Col. 1:14 "through His blood" is out.
 1 Thes 1:1 Peace "from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ" is out.
 1 Tim 3:16 "God" is changed to "He" (God is always plural, "He" is singular. This happens throughout).
 Heb 10:34 "in heaven" is out.
 1 Pet 1:22 "Through the Spirit" is out – radically changes Pneumatology doctrine shifting from God to man.
 1 Pet 5:11 "Glory" is out.
 Rev 1:8 "the beginning and the end" is out.
 Rev 1:11 "I am Alpha and Omega the first and the last" is out.
 Rev 5:14 "Him that liveth for ever and ever" is out.
 Rev 20:12 "God" is changed to "throne".
 Rev 21:24 "of them which are saved" is out.
 There are so many, many more.

Another helpful hint when reading the KJV is to keep in mind the difference between singular and plural in the personal pronouns. Ye, you, and your start with a "Y" and are **plural**. Thee, thy, and thou start with a "T" and are **singular**. This is important when studying the Bible for doctrinal truths. Can you see the difference it makes in John 3:7? (Hint – the doctrine of tricotomy: body, soul & spirit, all three need to be alive).

The Webster dictionary defines "teaching" merely as "that which is taught" and "doctrine" is tenacious "accepted as authoritative ... dogmas that are true and beyond dispute". Timothy, under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit warned us when he wrote in 2 Tim 4:3 – For the time will come when they will not endure sound **doctrine**; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves **teachers** ...

2 Thes 2:2-3 – That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand. (This whole thing is prophesied to occur world wide – the manuscripts have been changed).

NKJV omits the word "Lord" 66 times.
